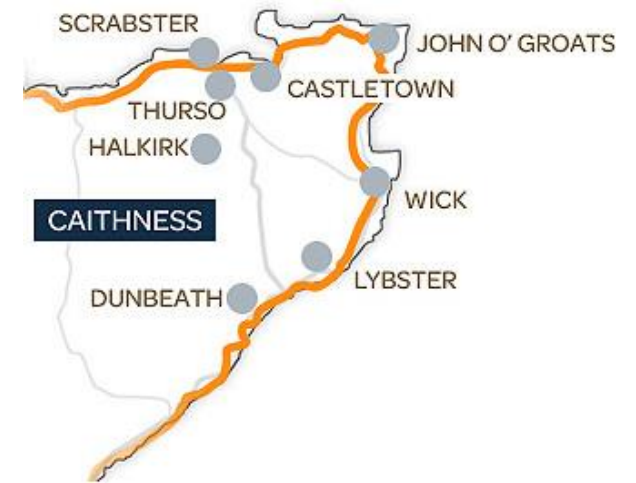

Caithness has two major towns, Thurso and Wick. Thurso has good in town shopping where Wick has good out of town shopping. There is some rivalry between the two towns which host the County Show alternately.

Ebenezer Place, in **Wick**, Caithness, Scotland, is credited by the Guinness Book of Records as being the world's **shortest street** at 2.06 m (6 ft 9 in). The **street** has only one address: the entrance to No. 1 Bistro, which is part of Mackays Hotel. Wick is the capital of Caithness and has a population of approximately 7,000.

Wick is divided into two by the river, to the south it is called "Pultneytown" and to the north "Wick". The distinction is lost on most visitors but helps explain the origin of the Pultneytown Distillery. Caithness has two major towns, Thurso and Wick. Thurso has good in town shopping where Wick has good out of town shopping. There is some rivalry between the two towns which host the County Show palternately.
